

## Scriptures for Healing

Take the scriptures like medicine daily (Proverbs 4:20-22) until every symptom disappears. Take it the same way you would pills -- several scriptures per dose, several times each day. The more you take, the better. Prescription:

“To be spoken by mouth three times a day until faith comes, then once a day to maintain faith. If circumstances grow worse, double the dosage. There are no harmful side effects.” — Charles Capps

#### **7 Reasons We are to Speak God's Word Aloud**

1. Faith comes by hearing... (Romans 10:17).
2. God says to meditate in the Word day and night (Joshua 1:8). The Hebrew word “hagah,” translated ‘meditate’ here, also means to mutter, murmur or sigh. Those all involve making sound. (Another Hebrew word translated as ‘meditate’ means to muse or rehearse in one’s mind. So God made clear the importance of speaking scripture aloud.) The idea that people who talk to themselves are losing it, mentally, is an old lie from the enemy to trick us out of the **benefits** of using the scriptures as our Father instructed!
3. Angels hearken to the voice of God's Word (Psalm 103:20). This means that angels go to work on your behalf when you speak (give voice to) scripture.

4. Speaking the Word is a surefire way of making your words agree with God's. This is a part of spiritual warfare, and we know that being aggressive toward the enemy causes him to flee (James 4:7). Why does he flee so quickly? He knows he has no power -- we do, because we have the Holy Spirit in us (1 John 4:4).
5. When you hear scripture, you are literally listening to what God is speaking to you -- always a good thing. Never say again that you can't hear God!
6. It helps you to receive the revelation contained in each passage. Get still for a moment and hear what God is revealing through the words you just spoke. This is part of renewing your mind -- shifting your mindset to agree with God's. We are instructed specifically to do this (Romans 12:2).
7. It foils the enemy's plans. You may feel resistant toward speaking the Word aloud. My lips clamped shut! That was proof to me that the enemy was trying to stop me from receiving the benefit that come with doing things God's way.

SPEAK the Word! And feel free to personalize scripture. It's for YOU, so substitute your name or "me" and "my" in scripture to help your mind accept that it's talking about you.

## HEALING SCRIPTURES

### Old Testament

Exodus 15:26

**...for I am the Lord that healeth thee.**

Psalms 107:20

**He sent His Word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions.**

Jesus is the Word made flesh, and He healed them ALL – all people, all diseases, no qualifiers.

Proverbs 4:20-24

**My son, attend to my words; incline thine ear unto my sayings. Let them not depart from thine eyes; keep them in the midst of thine heart. For they are life unto those that find them, and health to all their flesh. Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life. Put away from thee a froward mouth, and perverse lips put far from thee.**

Life and health to your flesh! Instructions: guard your heart. (be careful what you believe and are influenced by) and watch your words.

Exodus 23:25-26

**And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.**

Psalm 118:17

**I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the Lord.**

Deuteronomy 7:14-15

**Thou shalt be blessed above all people: there shall not be male or female barren among you... or among your cattle. And the Lord will take away from thee all sickness...**

Joel 3:10

**... let the weak say, I am strong.**

Psalm 23:1-4

**The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters. He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake. Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.**

A shadow never hurt anyone! The staff is for guiding and rescuing. The rod is not for beating bad sheep – it's for beating off the wolves and lions.

Psalm 30:2

**LORD my God, I called to you for help, and you healed me.**

Jeremiah 30:17

**'But I will restore you to health and heal your wounds,' declares the LORD...**

Proverbs 16:24

**Gracious words are a honeycomb, sweet to the soul and healing to the bones.**

Proverbs 3:5-8

**Trust in the LORD with all your heart, and lean not on your own understanding. In all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Do not be wise in your own eyes; fear the LORD and shun evil. This will bring health to your body and nourishment to your bones.**

Malachi 4:2

**But for you who fear My name, the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its wings. You shall go out leaping like calves from the stall.**

Psalm 107:17, 19-21

**Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. Oh that men would praise the Lord for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!**

Psalm 6:2

**"Have mercy on me, LORD, for I am faint; heal me, LORD, for my bones are in agony."**

Psalm 119:50

**This is my comfort in my affliction, that your promise gives me life.**

Isaiah 53:4-5

**Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

Psalm 34:17-18

**The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles. The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.**

Malachi 4:2 ESV

**But for you who fear my name, the sun of righteousness shall rise with healing in its wings. You shall go out leaping like calves from the stall.**

Proverbs 17:22

**A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.**

Isaiah 42:18

**Hear, you deaf! And look, you blind, that you may see.**

Psalm 146:8 ESV

**The Lord opens the eyes of the blind. The Lord lifts up those who are bowed down; the Lord loves the righteous.**

Isaiah 33:2

**“LORD, be gracious to us; we long for you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation in time of distress.”**

Isaiah 40:29,31

**He gives power to the weak, and to those who have no might He increases strength...Those who wait on the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.**

Nahum 1:9

**What do ye imagine against the Lord? he will make an utter end: affliction shall not rise up the second time.**

Keep your healing!

## **New Testament**

3 John 2

**Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.**

Matthew 4:23

**And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people.**

Matthew 11:5

**the blind receive sight and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them.**

Matthew 8:2-3

**And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.**

The term translated as "I will" means: it is my deep desire, my nature to do so.

Mark 7:35

**And his ears were opened, and the impediment of his tongue was removed, and he began speaking plainly.**

Matthew 8:16-17

**When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.**

Not only is this a wonderful healing scripture in itself, it proves that Isaiah's prophecies about Jesus' work on the cross includes healing of physical infirmities as opposed to the "spiritual healing." It is proof of healing in the atonement.

Matthew 15:30-31

**And great multitudes came unto him, having with them those that were lame, blind, dumb, maimed, and many others, and cast them down at Jesus' feet; and he healed them: insomuch that the multitude wondered, when they saw the dumb to speak, the maimed to be whole, the lame to walk, and the blind to see: and they glorified the God of Israel.**

God gets glory from your healing, not your sickness.

Matthew 21:22

**And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, BELIEVING, ye shall receive.**

Mark 9:23

**Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth**

Mark 10:27

**And Jesus looking upon them saith, With men it is impossible, but not with God: for with God all things are possible.**

Luke 6:19

**And the whole multitude sought to touch him: for there went virtue out of him, and healed them all.**

Acts 5:16

**There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, and them which were vexed with unclean spirits: and they were healed every one.**

Luke 9:2

**And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick.**

Acts 10:38

**How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.**

Romans 8:2

**For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.**

You are no longer under the law that says the wages of sin is death!

Romans 8:11

**But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwelleth in you.**

The Holy Spirit in you give life to your physical body. So what are you worrying about?

Hebrews 11:11

**Through faith also Sarah herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.**

Hebrews 13:8

**Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and today, and forever.**

James 4:7

**Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.**

1 Peter 2:24

**He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.**

1 John 5:14-15

**And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.**

Philippians 4:19

**And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.**

3 John 1:2

**“Beloved, I pray that all may go well with you and that you may be in good health, as it goes well with your soul.”**

Matthew 9:35

**Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.**

1 Peter 2:24 ESV

**He himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been healed.**

Luke 4:18 ESV

**The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed.**

Luke 13:10-17 ESV

**Now he was teaching in one of the synagogues on the Sabbath. And behold, there was a woman who had had a disabling spirit for eighteen years. She was bent over and could not fully straighten**

herself. When Jesus saw her, he called her over and said to her, “Woman, you are freed from your disability.” And he laid his hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and she glorified God. But the ruler of the synagogue, indignant because Jesus had healed on the Sabbath, said to the people, “There are six days in which work ought to be done. Come on those days and be healed, and not on the Sabbath day.” Then the Lord answered him, “You hypocrites! Does not each of you on the Sabbath untie his ox or his donkey from the manger and lead it away to water it? And ought not this woman, a daughter of Abraham whom Satan bound for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath day?” As he said these things, all his adversaries were put to shame, and all the people rejoiced at all the glorious things that were done by him.

First He delivered, “freed,” her from oppression by... who? Not God. It is satan that steals, kills and destroys. Then He healed her.

Luke 10:9 CSB

**Heal the sick who are there, and tell them, ‘The kingdom of God has come near you.’**

**I RECOMMEND THESE FOR MENTAL AND EMOTIONAL HEALTH** (though many above also apply and vice versa):

Psalm 34:18

**The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.**

Psalm 147:3

**He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.**

Psalm 23

**He restoreth my soul...**

Isaiah 33:2

**“LORD, be gracious to us; we long for you. Be our strength every morning, our salvation in time of distress.”**

Philippians 4:6-9 (AMPC)

**Do not fret or have any anxiety about anything, but in every circumstance and in everything, by prayer and petition (definite requests), with thanksgiving, continue to make your wants known to God. And God's peace [shall be yours, that tranquil state of a soul assured of its salvation through Christ, and so fearing nothing from God and being content with its earthly lot of whatever sort that is, that peace] which transcends all understanding shall garrison and mount guard over your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. For the rest, brethren, whatever is true, whatever is worthy of reverence and is honorable and seemly, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely and lovable, whatever is kind and winsome and gracious, if there is any virtue and excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think on and weigh and take account of these things [fix your minds on them]. Practice what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me, and model your way of living on it, and the God of peace (of untroubled, undisturbed well-being) will be with you.**

2 Timothy 1:7

**For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.**

2 Kings 20:5

**...Thus says the Lord, the God of David your father: I have heard your prayer; I have seen your tears. Behold, I will heal you...**

Proverbs 17:22

**A merry heart doeth good *like* a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones.**

When you meditate on the goodness of God, you can develop a merry heart. Praise Him! It builds faith, brings strength, and joy rises up.

Encourage yourself in the Lord as King David recommended. It may seem like an uphill battle right now, but even these scriptures are reason to rejoice.

Isaiah 41:10

**Fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.**

Isaiah 53:4-5

**...the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.**

Philippians 4:6-7

**“Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.”**

John 14:27

**“Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.”**

## **SCRIPTURES THAT DISPLAY THE LINK BETWEEN YOUR FORGIVENESS AND YOUR HEALING**

– Rejoice! If you are saved, you are forgiven. If you are forgiven, you are healed! If you are not saved yet, that’s an easy fix.

Isaiah 38:16-17

**“...You restored me to health and let me live... In your love you kept me from the pit of destruction; you have put all my sins behind your back.”**

James 5:14-16

**...And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him.**

Isaiah 53:5 ESV

**But he was pierced for our transgressions; he was crushed for our iniquities; upon him was the chastisement that brought us peace, and with his wounds we are healed.**

Jeremiah 17:14

**Heal me, O Lord, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou art my praise.**

Psalm 103:1-5

**Bless the Lord, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the Lord, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.**

## **HOW TO FIGHT FOR YOUR HEALING**

Matthew 18:18-19

**Verily I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever ye shall loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven. Again I say unto you, That if two of you shall agree on earth as touching any thing that they shall ask, it shall be done for them of my Father which is in heaven.**

Hebrews 10:35-36

**Cast not away therefore your confidence, which hath great recompence of reward. For ye have need of patience, that, after ye have done the will of God, ye might receive the promise.**

Matthew 10:8 ESV

**Heal the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, cast out demons. You received without paying; give without pay.**

Helping others receive their healing is often the way to your own.

Luke 8:50

**But when Jesus heard it, he answered him, saying, Fear not: believe only, and she shall be made whole.**

1 John 3:21-22

**Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, then have we confidence toward God. And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.**

This verse is not about earning your healing. We receive what we ask because we have confidence in God. If we are in self-condemnation, we lose our confidence that God wants to bless us, even though that is not God's way.

Mark 11:22-24

**And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.**

2 Corinthians 10:5

**...casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ.**

Visualize yourself grabbing every dark thought, and throwing it under Jesus' feet. It worked for me!

Mark 10:52 ESV

**And Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your faith has made you well." And immediately he recovered his sight and followed him on the way.**  
Note that faith came first, then healing.

Hebrews 10:23

**Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised).**

Luke 6:19

**“And the people all tried to touch him, because power was coming from him and healing them all.”** Get close to Jesus!
